

Les Corts is proud of its shops and its retailers. Local shops, a personal touch, high-quality produce... and all just around the corner! And for commerce, associations are a key factor for creating ties, new initiatives, improving competitiveness, adapting to change and improving neighbourhood cohesion. This year, they are the protagonists of the Festa Major opening speeches. For many reasons: because they are part of the district's social fabric, because they help to form local-resident networks, because they take part in social projects, because they know the stories of local residents who shop in their establishments every day and because they know the area better than anyone!

The district has four retailers' associations and shopping hubs, with dozens of members offering locally-sourced produce and services. And for those who don't know about them, here is a brief presentation: Cor de les Corts, in the Les Corts neighbourhood, is an association for retailers and business people that aims to revitalise, showcase and foster local commerce and hospitality establishments, while also encouraging them to work together with local organisations and large-scale operators in the area. At the northern end of the district, we find Mirall de Pedralbes, which is over 25 years old. It aims to foster and promote local commerce in the area, generating activities of interest to the commercial establishments, as well as consumers and local residents. La Maternitat i Sant Ramon is home to the youngest retailers' association, Les Corts Comerç 08028, created in 2017 with the aim of fostering and contributing to the development and improvement of member shops and businesses, as well as promoting places for people to meet and communicate. And lastly, there is Eix Comercial Sants - Les Corts, which we share with the Sants-Montjuïc district. It was set up in 2005 and has become a non-profit organisation. Eix Comercial brings together the commercial establishments in Galileu, Vallespir, Joan Güell and other streets in the area, fostering local commerce based on professionalism, locally-sourced produce and quality.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ENJOYING THE FESTIVAL



On the occasion of the Les Corts Annual Festival, jointly organised by the district's organisations and associations and the District of Les Corts, the following resolutions are established:

Foreword

Some rules of behaviour must be followed so that citizens, visitors and local residents can enjoy the festival and have the best possible time celebrating in the streets, and for the festival to proceed without problems.

In Les Corts, no means no

At our festival sexist attitudes, behaviour and conduct are not tolerated. Let's enjoy the festival with respect and equality! You will find *punts liles* [purple points] at the concert venues.

The festival sleeps too

So that people who don't want to join in the action can sleep, from Sunday to Thursday the festivities end at twelve midnight. On Fridays

and Saturdays, the eve of holiday days for many, the festivities can carry on until 2:30 am. The music will stop at this time, no more drinks will be sold and silence will reign in the neighbourhood.

Toilets

During their opening hours, all bars and other establishments must allow their toilets to be used by anyone who asks, whether or not they are customers. In all the festival venues there will be a toilet available for use by anybody.

Stalls, tables and other set-ups

No desks, tables and chairs, stalls or similar objects may be set up in the streets without specific permission issued by Les Corts District.

Alcoholic beverages and minors

As stipulated by law, the sale and consumption of alcoholic drinks by people under the age of 18 is prohibited. Furthermore, as always, the Festa Major organisers request celebrations with respect and awareness in regard to alcohol consumption. In this regard, the District is promoting the responsible consumption of these drinks, and for that reason, it has specifically trained the staff at festival bars who serve the public. There will also be information points about this matter in the festival spaces.

Street hawking

To guarantee the quality of the products that can be bought during the festival and to reward the efforts the authorised establishments make to fund it, street hawking is prohibited.





Wear appropriate clothing: cotton clothes with a closed collar, long sleeves, a neckerchief around your neck, flexible, lightweight and enclosed footwear and earplugs. The more you cover, the less chance of suffering burns and the more fun you will have.

Do not throw water on the fire devils: wet gunpowder is unpredictable. Do not bring your own firework products. Respect the fire devils and the carriers and do not obstruct their path.

If you go with children, do not go in the front rows; they can often take fright and, furthermore, it can be dangerous.

Follow the devils' instructions at all times.

If you have a shop along the route, remove any obstacles that could obstruct the route of the fire run. Wind in any canopies, cover up glass windows and pull down any blinds.
