We have the pleasure of introducing you to Xavier Solà Vilaseca, a resident of Les Corts, journalist and communicator. He has been directing and hosting the programme *La Nit dels Ignorants 3.0* on Catalunya Ràdio for 15 years, a modern night-time radio classic over 37 years old.

With a degree in Communication from the Open University (UOC) and history studies from Barcelona University (UB), Xavier Solà got his start in radio at the age of 17 in Sant Feliu de Guíxols, his hometown. After that he worked at Radio Almería (during his military service), Ràdio Girona, Ràdio Associació de Catalunya (now RAC 105), and has been with Catalunya Ràdio since 1985. At the latter, he has directed and hosted programmes like *Flash Glass*, *Xavier*, *Servei nocturn*, *En fresc*, *El Suplement* (which earned him a 2005 Ondas award), *Fixa't com sona*, *Suc de coco* and *La Nit dels Ignorants 3.0* since 2010. He also directed and hosted *Viatge de noces* on TV3 in 2011.

Born in the Empordà, he arrived in Barcelona in the summer of 1985 to begin his stint in radio in the capital of Catalonia. Just one year later, he laid down roots in Les Corts district, where he has lived for 40 years, in love with the neighbourhood and Barcelona.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ENJOYING THE FESTIVAL

Preamble

In order for citizens, visitors and neighbourhood people to enjoy the Festa Major, we must all follow certain rules of behaviour to make sure the festival is successful.

In Les Corts, no means no

At our festival sexist attitudes, behaviour and conduct are not tolerated. Let's enjoy the festival with respect and equality! You can find Purple Points in the following places:

- Joint fire run, Saturday 5 October starting at 11 pm at Plaça de la Concòrdia.
- Assortment of traditions, Sunday 6 October starting at 10 am in Plaça de Comas.
- Concert, Friday 11 October starting at 10:30 pm in Plaça de la Concòrdia.
- Festa Major Morning in Benavent, Saturday 12 October starting at 10 am on Carrer Benavent and Plaça de les Ceràmiques Vicens.
- Youth night, Saturday 12 October starting at 9:45 pm in Plaça del Sòl de Baix.
- Concerts, Saturday 12 October starting at 10:15 pm in Plaça de la Concòrdia.

The festival sleeps, too

From Sunday to Thursday, the festivities end at twelve midnight so that people who don't want to join in the action can sleep. The festival can go on until 2:30 am on Fridays and Saturdays, the nights before many people's day off. The music will stop at this time, no more drinks will be sold and silence will reign in the neighbourhood.

Toilets

During their opening hours, all bars and other establishments must allow their toilets to be used by anyone who asks, whether or not they are customers. There will be a toilet available in all the festival venues for anybody to use.

Stalls, tables and other set-ups

No desks, tables and chairs, stalls or similar objects may be set up in the streets without specific permission from Les Corts District.

Alcoholic beverages and minors

As stipulated by law, the sale and consumption of alcoholic drinks by people under the age of 18 is prohibited. Furthermore, as always, the Festa Major organisers request celebrations with respect and awareness in regard to alcohol consumption. In this regard, the District has specifically trained its people staffing the Festa Major's bars serving the public. There will also be information points about this matter in the festival spaces.

Street hawking

To guarantee the quality of the products that can be bought during the festival and to reward the efforts the authorised establishments make to fund it, street hawking is prohibited.

Let's make the Festa sustainable

Bring your own cup from home to make the Festa sustainable!

Recommendations for the fire run and other fire-based activities

- Cover yourself along the route to avoid sparks.
- Do not throw liquids onto the fire festival groups: wet gunpowder is dangerous and would be risky for everyone.
- Do not bring your own fireworks products. Respect the fire figures and people carrying them and do not get in the way of the fire festival groups.
- Keep doors and windows closed, blinds down and windows and displays protected (we recommend cardboard). Do not leave clothing hanging or any other items on balconies or windows like flags, etc.
- Do not place anything that could hinder the performance or people moving around easily (pots, tables, chairs, etc.).
- Do not enter the space where the fire group is going to perform, and do not grab or disturb any of its members.
